Founded nearly four decades ago in the global creative capital of Los Angeles, the LA County High School for the Arts (LACHSA) is the #1 Arts High School in the Nation* for student artists whose undeniable talent and fearlessly authentic voices change the world. LACHSA students come from every part of Los Angeles County and exemplify its wide-ranging diversity.

LACHSA students study with professional teaching artists to sharpen their critical thinking and strengthen their skills in core academics and five arts disciplines – cinematic arts, dance, theatre, music, and visual arts.

They go on to thrive at top colleges and arts conservatory programs and establish themselves as leaders in their chosen fields of art or study. LACHSA students become the significant artists and individuals they were always meant to be.

LACHSA has a nearly 100% graduation rate and our students have been offered over \$14 million annually in scholarships to attend schools such as The Juilliard School, Berklee School of Music, CalArts, NYU Tisch, RISD, Oberlin, Yale, Art Institute of Chicago, Stanford, UCLA, USC, University of Michigan, and Carnegie Mellon.

Josh Groban is an internationally renowned singer, songwriter, actor and producer with four multi-platinum albums and over 25 million records sold worldwide.



Matthew Rushing was a principal dancer and is now Associate Artistic Director for the Alvin Aliley Dance Theatre of America, and is considered one of the most acclaimed dancers in the country.



Angel Blue made her debut with the San Francisco Opera Company as "Clara" in *Porgy and Bess*, and the operatic soprano and classical crossover artist has been a featured soloist in concert and opera halls worldwide.



Josefina Lopez, Founder and Artistic Director of Casa 0101 Theater, wrote *Real Women Have Curves* — which won the top prize at Sundance Film Festival and was produced by HBO — while still a LACHSA student.

Kris Bowers, a Grammy and Oscar-nominated composer and pianist, has composed for film and television including Kobe Bryant's *Muse, Green Book, Bridgerton, King Richard* and artists Jay-Z and Kanye West.
